



## REGISTRATION INFORMATION

**CITC will hold registration for the Spring 2018 semester on:**

- **APPRENTICES MUST MAKE AN APPOINTMENT TO REGISTER.**
- If apprentices arrive more than 10 minutes late, they will have to wait for the next available appointment.
- Apprentices must fill out their registration packet **PRIOR TO** coming to registration.
- All registration packets will be emailed to each contractor.
- Apprentices will be notified of class day/time prior to the start of the semester.
- Apprentices will be required to take a math assessment that will include the following topics:
  - **Basic arithmetic:** addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division of whole numbers, fractions, and decimals.
  - **Basic Algebraic equations**
  - **Basic Geometry**
- They are given one hour in which to take the test.
- No calculator, cell phone, or other assistance is allowed.
- If apprentices receive a score below 70% they will be required to attend a math review class during the spring semester of school.

- Registration takes approximately 2 hours (including math assessment).
- If your company has not already submitted an Intent to Hire form for each apprentice, please do so **PRIOR TO REGISTRATION**.

## **Spring 2018 registration quick points**

- 1<sup>st</sup> year apprentices only – call for test-out requirements
- All 1<sup>st</sup> year apprentices that start in Jan. 2018 will have to attend summer school
- Registration is by appointment only
- All inquiring apprentices after Oct. 20<sup>th</sup> will be placed on a waiting list

## **Test-out date and requirements**

- All test-outs will be held on October 27<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 am
- All required information must be completed before the test will be given
- The test costs \$150.00:
  - If the apprentice passes - \$50 of the \$150 will go towards their tuition
  - If the apprentice fails they will be required to start in the year they did not test-out of
  - The company will be invoiced for the test-out fee
- Electrical test-outs must have a minimum of 2,000 hours of experience documented through affidavits per each level they are testing out of
- Non-electrical apprentices must have a minimum of 2,000 hours of documented experience on company letterhead for each level they are trying to test-out of
- CITC must receive written confirmation from the company that they are authorizing the apprentice(s) to test-out
